Information on the paper text design:

- Size - from 5 to 12 pages, in Microsoft Word A4 size, font Times New Roman, size 12, paragraph (indent) - 20 mm., Line spacing - single;
- On the title page on the right in bold: the author's name and surname, academic degree, academic title, position, full name of the organization the author represents, e-mail address;
- Further below: the title of the report (in black, center alignment);

- Key words (no more than 6) in Azerbaijani, English and Russian;
- The text of the paper;
- At the end of the paper: an abstract characterizing the topic and issues of the paper, goals, novelty and results to represent the main content - in Azerbaijani, English and Russian;
- Sources used by the author are indicated in the «List of references» in alphabetical order. Citations are indicated in text at the bottom of the page;
- Illustrations are numbered and accompanied by short comments;

Papers that do not correspond to the thematic sections and do not meet formatting requirements will be returned.

The deadline for submission of papers is December 31, 2020, for abstracts - December 10, 2020. Abstracts must be composed according to the same rules and consist of 300-500 words.

Sessions of the sections of **I «International Readings in memoriam to M.E.Rasulzade»** - will be held in the buildings of the National Museum of the History of Azerbaijan ANAS (I section) and the National Museum of Azerbaijan Literature after Nizami Ganjavi ANAS (II section). The time and place of the Opening Ceremony will be announced additionally.

The papers selected for the **I «International Readings in memoriam to M.E.Rasulzade»** will be published in a separate volume.

The Organizing Committee will cover travel expenses, accommodation and meals for foreign participants, whose papers will be accepted to the conference program.
